<p>Seek active involvement of regional stakeholders. (Administrators, faculty, business & industry partners)</p>	
<p>Maintain the lines of communication between all regional stakeholders.</p>	
<p>Improve the linkages among CTE programs, EWD initiatives, all the CTE statewide advisory committees, & statewide discipline/industry collaborative projects; and Workforce Investment Act boards (WIB).</p>	
<p>Promote collaboration and linkages between groups, networking, sharing of best practices, and updates on legislative and other current events impacting the region.</p>	
<p>Encourage new and/or prospective CTE or EWD leaders to participate in the annual Leadership Institute in San Ramon, April 2012. Travel, lodging, transportation is reimbursed. Requires \$100 refundable deposit. (14 participants needed for 2012)</p>	
<p>Participate in statewide and regional workforce development marketing efforts. Encourage regional collaboration to market workforce development.</p>	
<p>Expand professional development that provides faculty and counselors w/ knowledge and skills to implement EWD preparation and improve programs, services, and access for special populations.</p>	
<p>Facilitate and coordinate assistance efforts to colleges that will be used to enable special population students to meet state-adjusted levels of performance.</p>
