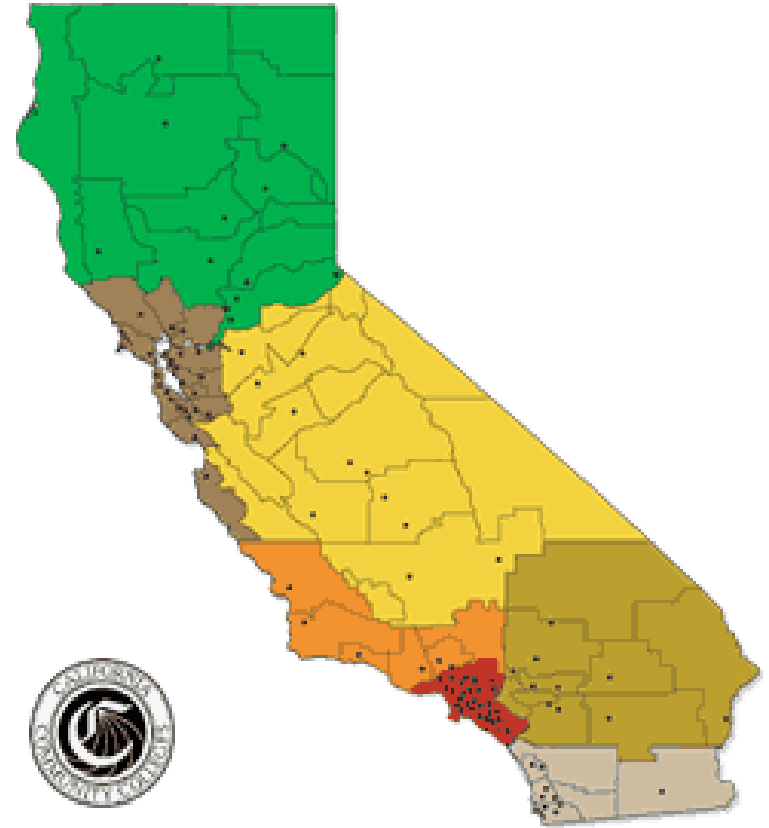

- Geographically located from Stockton in the north, east to the Nevada border, south to Taft, and west to the coastal communities of Gilroy and Salinas.
