California Higher Education is well poised to respond to the theme of this year's conference "Can We Change Fast Enough?" CHESC believes that we can change fast enough and the speakers we have chosen for this year's event will be able to describe how they have been making meaningful impacts in their communities.

Some of this year's highlights include a panel presentation by four university Presidents that have divested from fossil fuels (including our host campus!), a presentation from Stanford on how they will reduce their emissions by 80% in 2015, a discussion with regulators on how to rethink policy on water infrastructure to allow more innovative technology solutions, and several dialogues about system-wide university policies and what changes –we should make moving forward.
