- Arts, Audio Visual Technology and Communications includes a range of careers that involve designing, producing, exhibiting, performing, writing, and publishing multimedia content including visual and performing arts and design, journalism, and entertainment services.¹
- Educational attainment leads to large wage increases in this sector: Workers with some college credits earn almost \$20,000 more than those with a high school diploma or less.²
