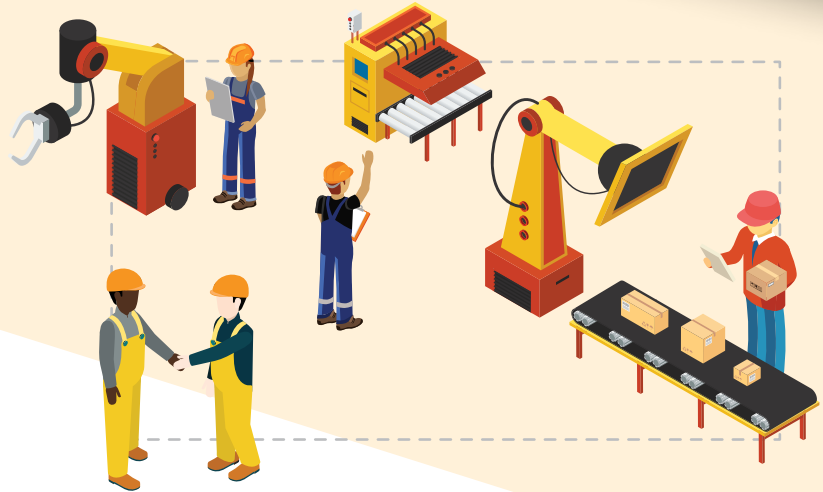

MANUFACTURING HIGHLIGHTS

- Manufacturing careers involve planning, managing and performing the processing of materials into intermediate or final products and related professional and technical support activities, such as production planning and control, maintenance and manufacturing/process engineering.¹
- By 2025, 3.5 million manufacturing jobs will need to be filled. Talent shortages mean skilled employees are in demand: About 70 percent of manufacturing executives report a lack of workers with the necessary computer and technical skills.²
