- Hospitality and Tourism careers encompass the management, marketing and operations of restaurants and other food services, lodging, attractions, recreation events and travel-related services.¹
- Many employees in this sector have built career pathways from entry-level jobs to higher-paying positions: 80 percent of restaurant owners, and 90 percent of restaurant managers, report that their first job in the industry was an entry-level position.²
