10:00 am - 10:15Welcome and Introductionsamof Steering CommitteeDr. Stacy Pfluger		Dr. Stacy Pfluger, <u>Vice Chancellor of Educational Services</u> , <u>Kern Community College District</u> , welcomed Deans and informed them they have the full support of Kern Community College District. It was shared with Deans that there are <u>Chancellor's Office updates for CVML</u> , in the shared folder.		
10:15 am - 10:30 am	Fiscal Updates/ <b>Beatrice</b> Licon	Beatrice Licon, <u>CVML Director Of Programs and Compliance</u> , shared the <u>Regional Consortium funds is</u> <u>\$286, 875</u> which are fully expended for years 6 & 7. 2024, the fiscal year is fully spent. The fiscal host also receives a <u>5% Administration fee</u> which is broken down: 47% goes to wages, 29% goes to benefits, 1% goes to supplies, 9% were computers that were purchased that rolled over, and 14% for desks that were purchased to build CVML team. Beatrice advised the breakdown for these are in the google folder. Beatrice advised monthly fiscal meetings to be coming out again, she encouraged Deans to attend		



		meetings.
		Region plans for SWP 7 & 8 will open September 21, 2024, if Deans are done with region plan budgets prior to October 5, 2024, please let Beatrice know that way she can submit and get it approved.
		Region wide year 7 projects have \$189,262 still unexpended. Beatrice received an extension to expend funds fully until June 30, 2025. She urged Deans to expend by December 30, 2024.
		Beatrice recommended if there are regional year 7 projects that need extension, reach out to the Chancellor's office, they should give yearlong extensions.
		Beatrice will be sending out emails to those colleges who have not expended their marketing funds.
		Beatrice suggested she meet with the Deans in the monthly meeting to advise how much is left region wide.
		Beatrice agreed if some college needed a reimbursement up front for Jump Start, we could do that, but we need the GL backup as soon as it's available.
		Becky requested a live spreadsheet of Marketing funds from Beatrice to be placed in the dean's folder by September 17, 2024.
