SUBJECT: Required Updated Data Sharing MOU for K12 SWP Round 9 Eligibility

The Central Valley Mother Lode (CVML) Regional Consortium would like to inform all current K12 Strong Workforce Program (K12 SWP) awardees of an important requirement for the upcoming Round 9 K12 SWP application cycle.

The California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) has updated the **K12SWP LEA CCCCCO Data Sharing Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)**. As a result, all LEAs applying for K12 SWP Round 9 funding will be required to have an executed, updated MOU on file and upload a copy of the signed agreement as supporting documentation with their application.

Beginning with Round 9, submission of the updated MOU will be required for an application to be considered eligible for funding.

The revised MOU:

- Removes outdated references to a prior vendor;
- Strengthens and clarifies FERPA-related language;
- Clarifies the Chancellor's Office responsibility for data security; and
- Supports the continued collection and use of student outcome data for K12 SWP reporting and evaluation purposes.

For LEAs that do not currently have an executed MOU, or whose existing agreement has not been updated, documentation demonstrating that the MOU is pending execution may be accepted if submitted by the application deadline, subject to Chancellor's Office guidance.

We encourage all LEAs to begin the review and signature process as soon as possible to avoid delays during the Round 9 application period.
